BE IT REMEMBERED on this day the Court reviewed the file in the above-styled cause, and specifically plaintiff's original petition, the live pleading in the above-captioned case for the plaintiff, and thereafter enters the following:


IT IS ORDERED that the plaintiff Institute for Creation for Research Graduate School file an amended complaint within fifteen (15) days of this date in compliance with the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure and the Standing Order of this District. The petition is 64 pages long with attached exhibits of 67 pages. Rule 8 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure require any pleading stating a claim for relief must contain "a short and plain statement of the claim showing that the pleader is entitled to relief; and a demand for the

relief sought, which may include relief in the alternative or different types of relief.” The rule further mandates “each allegation must be simple, concise, and direct.”

Under the local rules of this district, the complaint must be double spaced with bottom margins of at least one inch. The print shall be in 12 point type size with one inch margins.

Attached to this order is a copy of the standing order entered for the Austin Division on March 19, 2007.


