Barbara Forrest was [profiled](#) [4] in the January 2010 issue of *Church and State*, published by Americans United for Separation of Church and State. "For Barbara Forrest, fighting for church-state separation and quality science education in Louisiana — and the rest of the nation — has become her civic duty," the article explains, citing both her testimony in *Kitzmiller v. Dover* and her efforts to mitigate the impact of the so-called Louisiana Science Education Act, which threatens to open the door to creationism in the science classrooms of the state's public schools. A professor of philosophy at Southeastern Louisiana University, Forrest is the coauthor (with Paul R. Gross) of *Creationism's Trojan Horse* (rev. ed., Oxford University Press 2007), and a member of NCSE's board of directors.
