Entries may be related or unrelated to your own research, and should be suitable for use in a classroom. Videos should be both informative and entertaining.

The finalists will be screened at the Evolution 2017 meeting in Portland, Oregon. (You do not need to attend the conference in order to enter a video.) The winner will receive a prize of \$1000; the runner-up will receive a prize of \$500. The deadline to submit a video is 11:59 p.m. (EST), June 2, 2017.
